

AADA survey – 2010 (93 patients/107 caregivers)

Overall, are you satisfied with your atopic dermatitis treatment?

• Yes: 40

• No: 160



Poland²

Satisfaction with AD treatment in children (119 patients) – 2016

56% dissatisfied with the treatment

40% failed to adhere to at least one therapeutic recommendation

- Psychological support
- Obtaining reliable information
- Getting engaged in the treatment
- Dissatisfaction with the physician/diagnostics

Germany³

Treatment-related patient needs (1678 patients) – 2020

- To get better skin quickly: 7.8%
- To be healed of all skin defects: 85.7%
- To be free of itching: 96.0%
